This workshop is open to any teacher who wants to explore the use of digital media for engaging and enhancing student learning through writing. Working primarily in a Mac-platform, participants will use various hand-held mobile devices (iPads, iPods, iPhones) and digital tools to acquire strategies, skills, and the resources necessary to challenge students to be writers and producers of unique digital media.

Using the *California Common Core Standards*, teachers will plan writing assignments that are current and relevant while providing a rigorous curriculum that fosters critical thinking and allows all students, including English language learners, to be creators, communicators, collaborators, and writers in a dynamic world.

Hands-on use of digital media may include:

- exploration of free mobile apps
- iMovie / GarageBand
- Twitter in the classroom
- discussion of BYOD (bring your own device)
- Google Apps for Education
- Edmodo / Blogger (web-based resources)
